

The Bay Side Inn welcomes you to a tradition of relaxation, congeniality and comfort.




Enjoy your continental breakfast in the inviting warmth of the dining area that captures an exquisite view of the lake and mountains.



The Inn is located on Route 11D just 2 1/2 miles from the center of Alton Bay. From I-95 North, take Route 16 (Spaulding Turnpike) to Route 11 West to the Alton traffic circle. Continue on Route 11 to Alton Bay, turn right onto Route 11D, bear left and the Inn is a quarter of a mile on your right.

From I-93 North, take exit 15E at Concord to Route 4 & 202 East, to Route 28 North to Route 11 West at Alton traffic circle. Continue on Route 11 to Alton Bay, turn right onto 11D.

Sorry, pets are not permitted.


